God's Great Plan for His People Mt. 28:18-21

Mt 28:19 "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: teaching them to observe all things...I have commanded you."

This Great Commission reveals God's great plan and purpose!

- 1. Salvation: Luke 19:10 "The son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost." Phil. 1:6 speaks of the "fellowship (partnership) in the gospel"
 - A. Our Part: (As God's Messengers)
 - 1) <u>Declaration</u>! Mk 16:15 "Preach the gospel" Acts 1:8 "Ye shall be witnesses unto me..."
 - Ro. 10:14 "how can they believe on them in whom they have not heard? how can they hear without a preacher?"
 2) Explanation. "teach all nations" Mt. 28:19
 - a) The Meaning: mathēteu'ō (from mantha'nō) Help them to understand "the Gospel" Acts 8:30-31 "Understandest thou what thou readest? How can I, except some man should guide me?"

B. God's Part:

- 1) <u>Conviction</u>. Jn 16:8 "He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:"
- 2) <u>Illumination.</u> 2 Cor. 4:4,6 "the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them that believe not... But God who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts..."
- a) To those who will respond will experience:
 - (1) <u>Reconciliation</u>. 2 Cor. 5:19-21 "God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself..."
 - (2) <u>Adoption:</u> Ro 8:15-16 "ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father..."
 - (3) <u>Translation</u>: Col 1:13 "God...hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and translated us (transferred) into the kingdom of his dear Son:" (See 1 John 3:1-3)
- b) Those who don't respond will experience:
 - Heb. 2:3 "How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation?"
 - (1) <u>Rejection</u>: Mt 7:22-23 "then will I profess unto them, I never knew you! depart from me"
 - (2) <u>Condemnation</u>: John 3:17-18 "he that believeth not is condemned already!" (Mt. 25:41; Rev. 20:15)
- 2. Baptism. Mt. 28:19 "Baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost"

A. What is baptism?

1) The Meaning: Βαπτίζω (baptizo)

a) From a derivative of bapto; to make whelmed (1) To cover wholly; (2) To Dye or stain. "Baptized" is found 89 times in the Bible and it is always the word "baptizo"!

The Greek word Sprinkle is "rhantizo" (Heb. 9:13,19,21) and "Poured" is "ekche'o" (Rev. 16)

These two words are <u>never</u> translated "baptized" in the Bible.

Why did God consistently choose the word Baptizo in every one of the 89 references to Baptism?

2) The Biblical Method. (*Immersion*)

a) John the Baptist. John 3:23 "John also was baptizing in Aenon, because there was much water there."
 Mark 1:5 "Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to Him, and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River."

- b) Jesus: Mt 3:14-17 "comest thou to me? Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water..."
- c) Ethiopian: Acts 8:38-39 "they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. And when they were come up out of the water... the eunuch went on his way rejoicing."

B. Why is Baptism important to God?

1) Baptism = <u>Association</u>/Identification.

- a) Jesus was "associating" with his Father at his baptism. Mt 3:16-17
- b) At Baptism, the early believers were associating with:
 - (1) Jesus Acts 2:38 "Repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus..." (see also Ro 6:3-4)
 - (2) With His <u>Church</u>. Acts 2:41 "Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls."
 - 1 Cor 12:13-14, 27 "by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body... For the body is not one member, but many....Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular."

Conclusion:

If the meaning and method Salvation and biblical baptism is so clear, why is there so much confusion?

"God is not the author of confusion" (1 Cor. 14:43)

Application: Are you part of God's Great Plan?

Have you responded to His Salvation?
